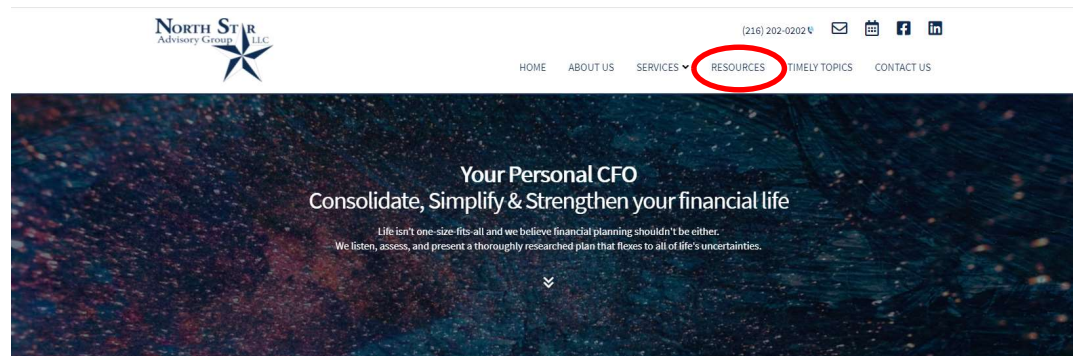

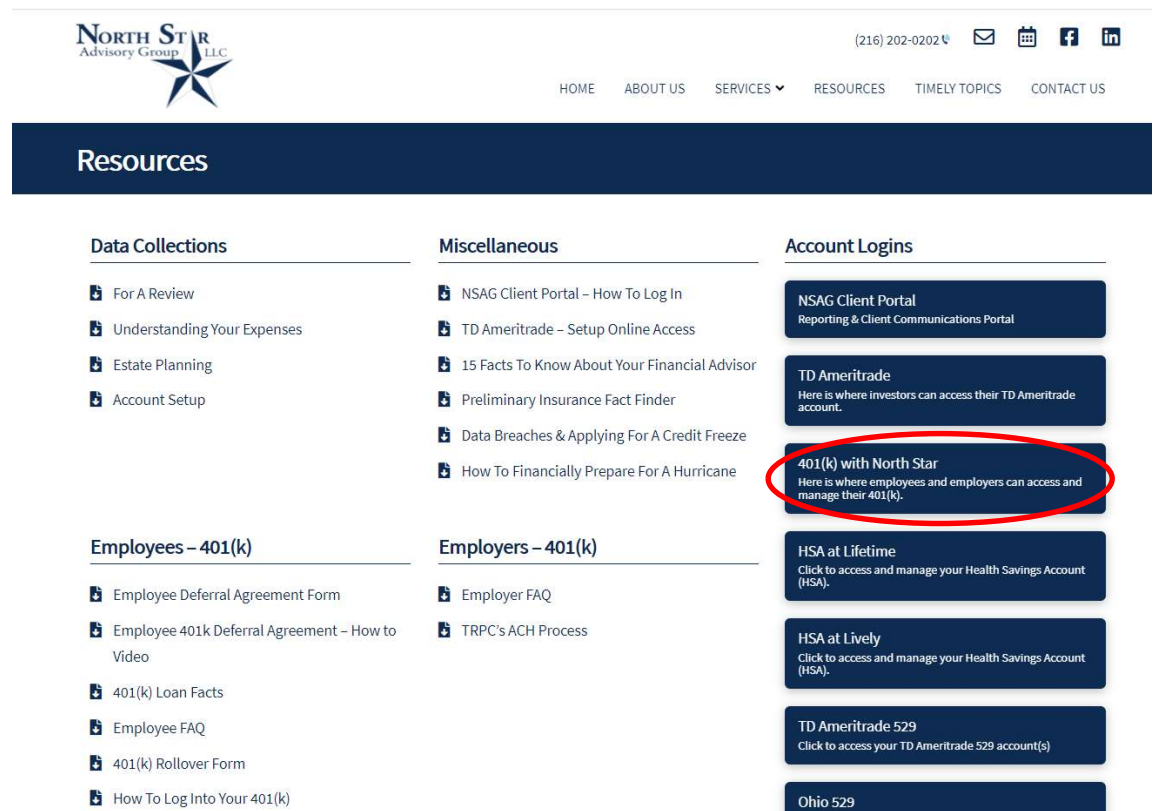

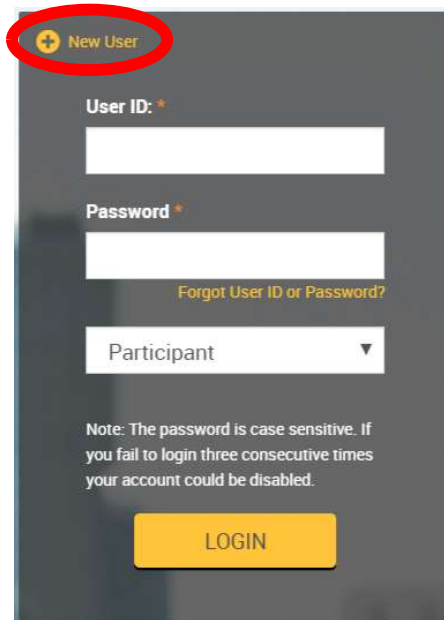


Step 2 Click on “401(k) with North Star”



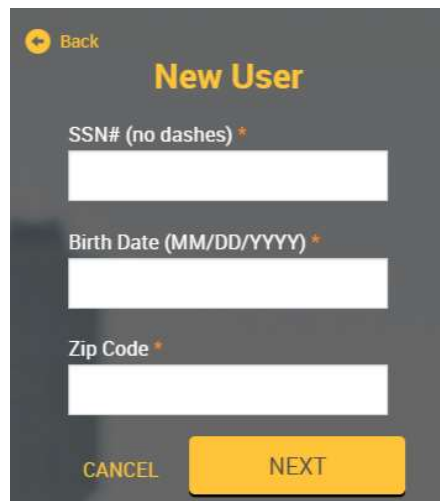
Step 3 Enter your login information
